



Dress Code for Golfers



DRESS REQUIREMENT:

A HIGH STANDARD OF DRESS IS EXPECTED ON THE COURSE AND IN AND AROUND THE CLUBHOUSE, AT ALL TIMES.

ON THE COURSE:

Tailor-made shorts no lower than the knee with knee length or sports socks, preferably white. Sports shirts must have collars. Trousers/slacks must not be tucked into socks. Shirts must be tucked into trousers or shorts. Denim Jeans, trainers, shell suits and collarless shirts are not allowed.

IN THE CLUBHOUSE:

Clothing must be of smart appearance. Smart denim jeans and clean trainers are allowed (not work clothes or torn jeans.)

Tailor-made shorts with socks, as above and appropriate footwear, are permitted in the clubhouse at any time with the exception of the presentation evenings.

CLOTHING NOT PERMITTED:

Track or shell suits, T-shirts with no collar or sleeves, waterproofs or working clothes.

MOBILE PHONES:

Except for medical emergencies, the use of mobile phones is not permitted on the course. Please set your phone to silent or vibrate to avoid disturbing other Golfers on the course.

The making and receiving of mobile phone calls in the Clubhouse is only acceptable on the balcony or on the upstairs landing, but is not permitted within any communal areas such as the Bar , Lounge, Dining Room or the 19th - in all cases please use the silent or vibrate setting.

It is acceptable to use your mobile phone, tablet or computer for personal internet use in the upstairs communal areas, but please have respect for those around you.

Members and Visitors are welcome to use the Club Wi-Fi service. The network name and password is displayed around the clubhouse.

THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ACCESS TO THE CLUBHOUSE OR COURSE TO ANYONE DRESSED INAPPROPRIATELY.
